Offered in an array of styles, colors, and shapes, porcelain ceramic sinks feature many unique benefits, including their heavy duty feel, and classy, sophisticated looks, while offering an integral overflow in almost all of the models available. Porcelain ceramic sinks are easy to clean and maintain. They can be enjoyed indefinitely with a little bit of regular care and maintenance.

The following types of cleaners should never be used:

- Coarse cleaners with grit (Ajax)
- Acidic chemicals
- Alcohol based cleaners

Keep abrasive cleaning pads away from your Porcelain Sink, including:

- Steel Wool
- Brillo Pads
- Pumice Products
- Wire Brushes

Never:

In order to prolong the life of your porcelain ceramic sink, simple daily maintenance is the key to keep your sink in its original condition. Clean your sink after each use with a soapy sponge, then rinse thoroughly with warm water. You may dry it with a towel or a dry cloth. This will eliminate water spots and streaks, while the sink is in use.

******Using abrasive bathroom cleaners (like Ajax) will scour and dull the ceramic and porcelain, causing it to lose luster and shine******
