

**Instructions:**

Rinsing is the most important part of sink care. The Pelican Int'l stainless steel sink will retain its original bright appearance if the sink is rinsed thoroughly after each use. This can be done by running water from the faucet spray hose for a few minutes. A rinse and towel dry after each use takes care of most everyday clean-ups. Once a week the sink should be scoured with a non-abrasive cleanser, rubbing in the same direction as the bowl finish (back and forth or a circular motion). This will blend any imperfections into the finish of the sink. Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry and your sink will shine.

**Always:**

- Clean everyday by thoroughly rinsing with a mild soap and warm water then wipe dry.
- Keep the sink free of any standing water as this can cause a buildup of mineral deposits, which can affect the appearance of your sink.
- Remove stubborn stains by gently scrubbing in the direction of the grain with a mild non-abrasive cleanser such as Soft Scrub.
- Rinse the sink after using any cleaning agent then wipe dry.
- Clean any mineral deposits built up over time with a mild solution of vinegar and water followed by a thorough flushing with water.
- Remove any scratches with a Scotch-Brite pad and cleaning agent. Rub in the direction of the grain. (Not recommended for silk satin and mirror bowl finishes)
